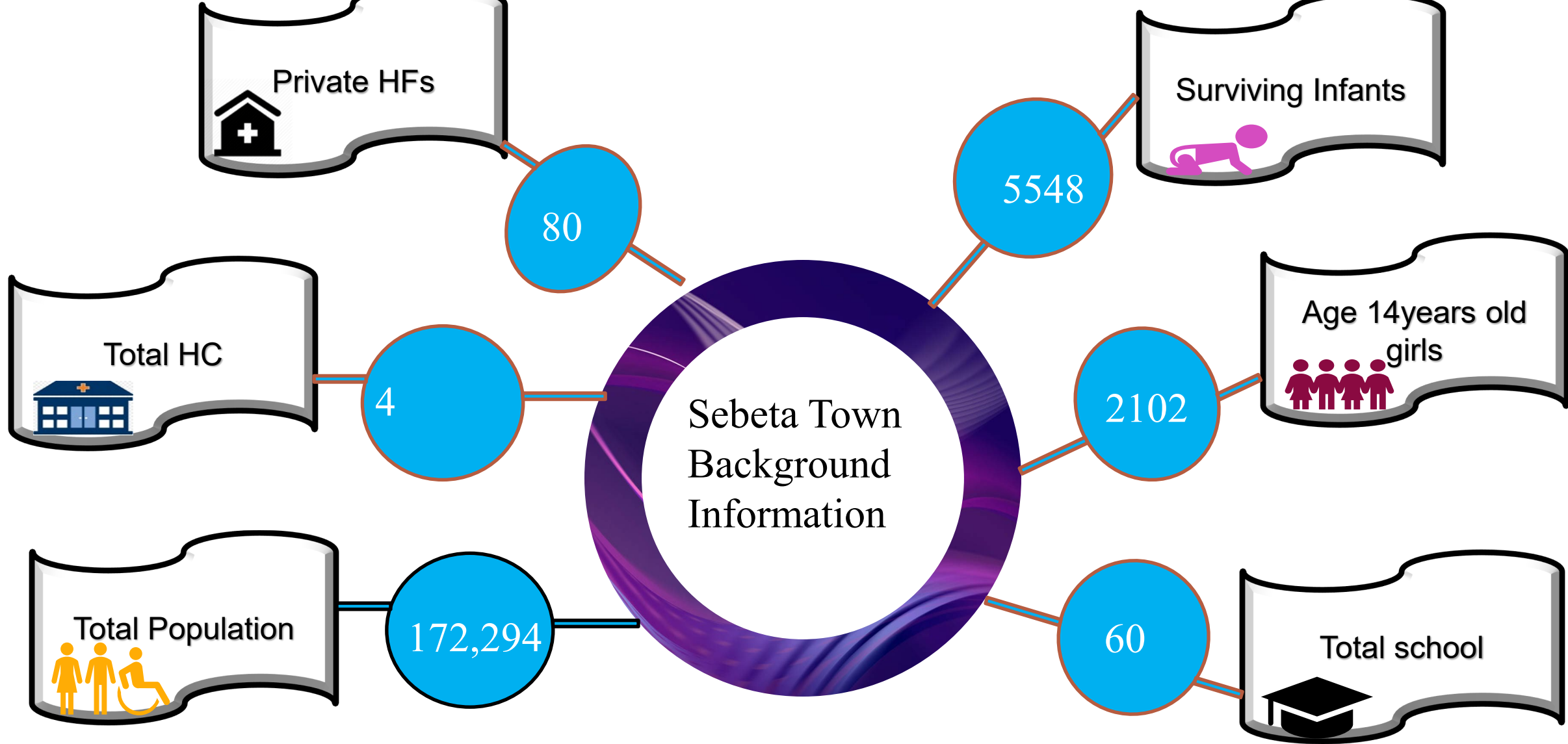

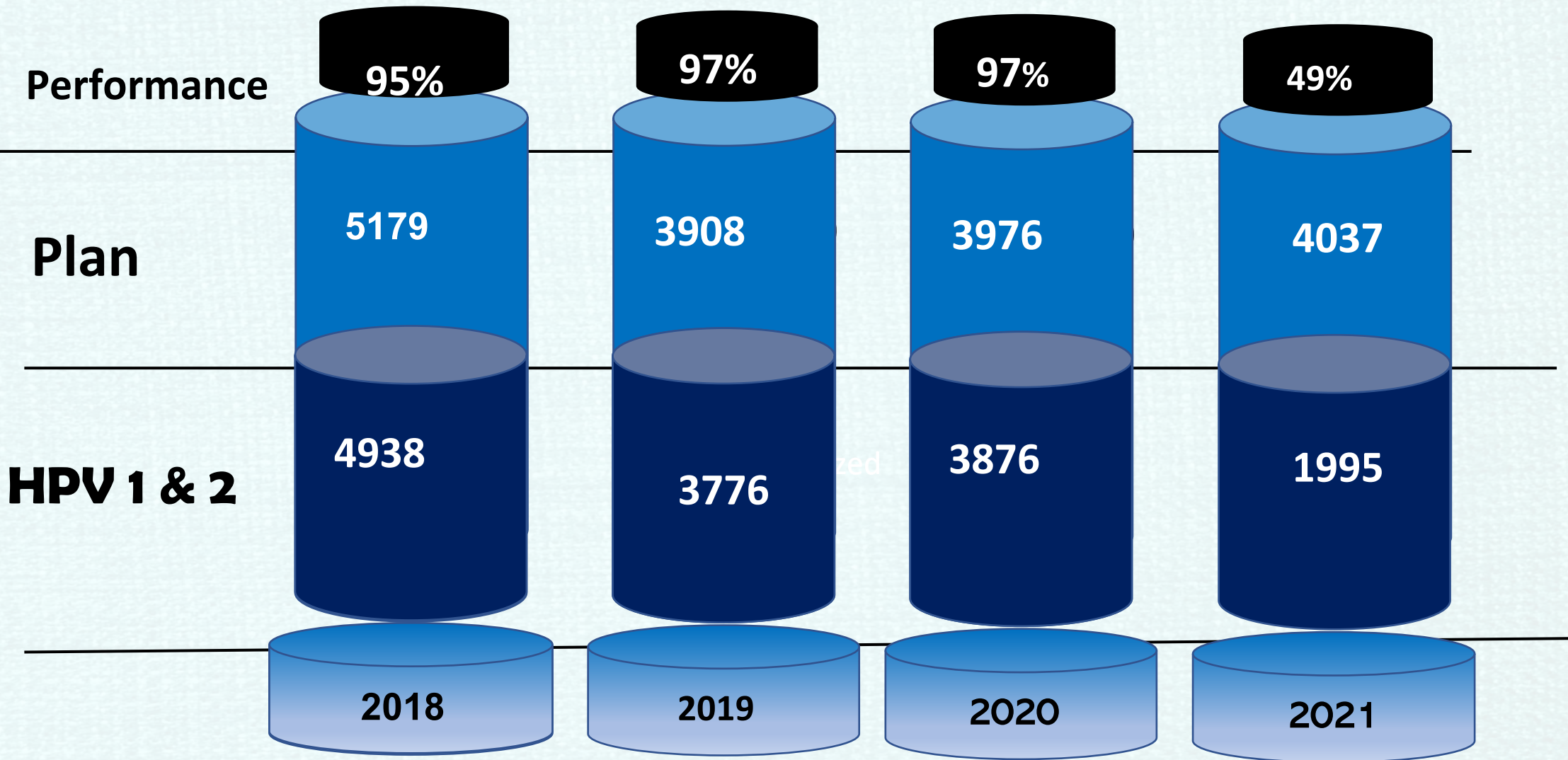

HPV Vaccination Overview

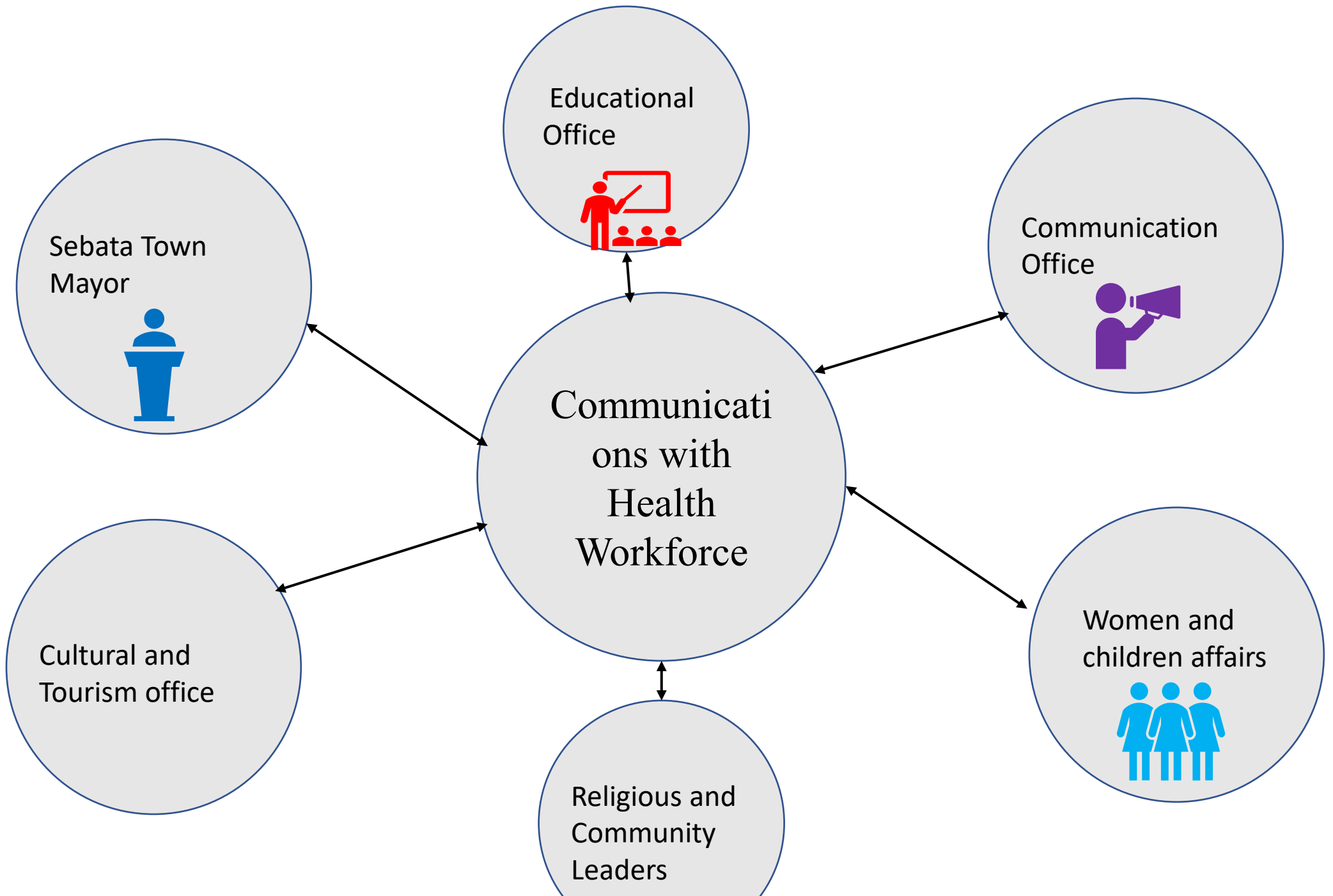
- Ethiopia introduced HPV vaccination on December 2018 for a single age cohort of 14-year-old girls
- Sebeta Town also started HPV Vaccination based on the MoH Direction using
 - School Based strategy
 - Outreach
 - Fixed posts/HF

Major Activities Conducted from 2018 to 2022

- Established Coordination Platform at all levels(TWGs)
- Conducted bottom up Micro-Plan and shared with the regions
- Capacity building activities (training and Supportive Supervision) Conducted
- Advocacy meetings (with Sebeta Town mayor, education office, communication, women and children affairs, culture and tourism and etc.), Media briefing and engagement activities have been conducted at different levels
- Cold Chain Capacity Assessment and restoration have been conducted
- Recording and reporting and Monitoring & Evaluation activities have been conducted

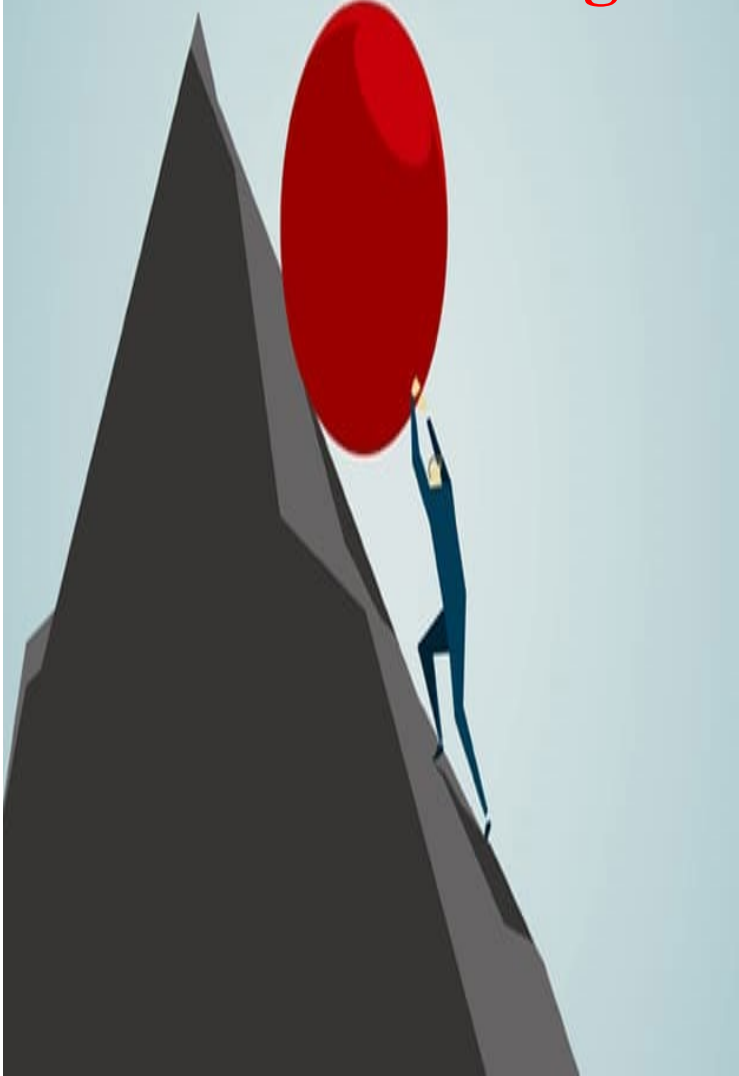

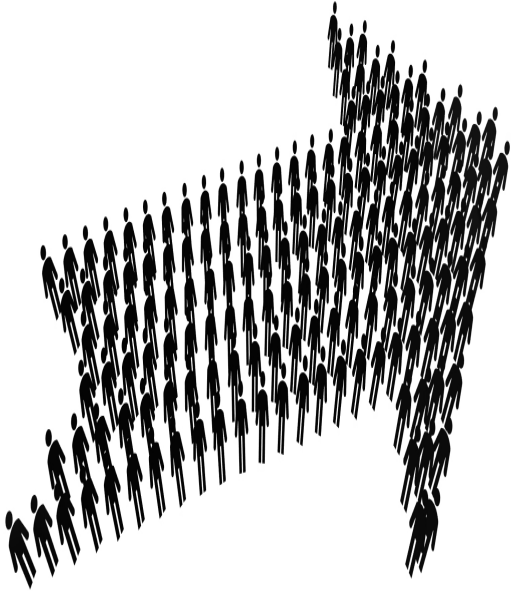
