


# HPV vaccination programme

- 12-13 year old girls
- HPV4 (Gardasil) vaccine used
- School based programme
  - Cohort ~30,000
  - 1st year of second level school
  - September/October and March/April
  - Clinics for those who miss out
- Parents sent information leaflet, consent form and contact details
  - Information literacy proofed
  - Contact details for vaccination teams
  - Referred to website for more information

#### Cervical cancer jab gets parental nod

AS MANY as 85pc of parent have so far given the goahead for their teenage daughters to receive the cervical cancer vaccine. Girls in several secondar, schools vesterday became

the first of 1,500 to receive the vaccine this term, but the majority will have to wait until September. The Health Service Executive (HSE) is offering the vaccine to all first-year secondary school girls, and plans to extend it to 21 schools before the end of

this term.
Parents, who were sent information packs and consent forms in advance of

the vaccination becoming available, have the right to refuse to let their daughter receive the injections. An estimated 30,000 of the current first year numi will receive the vaccine thi month or in September. The HSE will begin vaccinating the next round of students at the beginnin

of the next school year.

The girls need three jabs, with a second due around
July for those who will be inoculated this term.

The vaccine, Gardasil,

The vaccine, Gardasil, protects against the types of human papillomavirus (HPV) infection, which causes seven out of 10 of all cervical cancers.
It does not rule out the need for screening. Studies so far show protection lasts for at least five years after a full course, but more

research will be required to see if a booster shot will be needed.

Doctors said side effects were mild and allergic reactions were rare but fainting had been reported in a number of girls.





# HPV vaccine uptake 2010/2011 - 2016/2017


